

CHECK OUT, DOWNLOAD & ENJOY

Browse or search the site for audiobooks and eBooks. When you find a title you're interested in, add it to your cart and check it out.

Once you have checked out a title, a download page is displayed. Click the “Download” link to start the download. Once the download is complete, open and enjoy the title.

You will never accrue late fees with titles you download from this collection. Titles expire at the end of the loan period and they are automatically checked in to the library.

Once checked in with the system, the title is then available for the next patron. You may then delete the book from your device.

Each patron is allowed three books checked out at a time, regardless of the format. You may also have three books “on hold” under your account listing. These are books that are currently out to another patron. Selecting a title to be “on hold” puts you in line on the virtual queue.

Should you find books that you are interested in reading in the future, you may add them to your saved titles listing. As you decide to read them, you can add them to your cart and continue with the process. This is applicable to titles that are currently available or for those that are checked out to other patrons.

To check out and download you need...

- A valid library card
- Internet access
- A computer or device that meets the system requirements for the type(s) of materials you wish to download
- Free software for the computer or device on which you wish to use the materials available at this site

- Sony Reader
- Kobo eReader
- Android

To access either book format in the collection, you must first download and install the OverDrive Media Console.

- Windows Mobile 5 and 6
- Android v1.5 (or newer)
- BlackBerry v4.5 (or newer)

eBooks only

In order to read Adobe eBooks on your computer or device, you must also install Adobe Digital Editions.

ACTIVATE THE SOFTWARE

Additional steps may be needed to activate the software, depending on your operating system or device.

OverDrive Media Console: Windows

OverDrive Media Console for Windows utilizes Windows Media Player 9 (or newer) to play the DRM-protected audiobook files. The first time that Windows Media Player attempts to open a DRM-protected file, it will alert you that a security upgrade must be performed before the file can be opened.

OverDrive Media Console: Android and iPhone/iPad

To read Adobe EPUB eBooks you need to activate your device using an Adobe ID.

Adobe Digital Editions

Adobe Digital Editions can be activated anonymously or by using an Adobe ID. Anonymous activation allows you to download and read DRM-protected eBooks on a single computer only. Using an Adobe ID allows you to download and read DRM-protected eBooks on multiple computers and transfer them to supported eBook devices.
