MIDTERM EXAM RULES 2008 – 2009

1. Seniors are required to take midterm exams.
2. For semester courses where a final exam will be given, a senior may be exempt from the exam if s/he has maintained a B- average or better for the entire course and has earned at least a B- for the final marking period of the course.
3. On Thursday, January 22nd and Friday, January 23rd students only need to attend school when they have exams.
4. On Tuesday, January 20th and Wednesday, January 21st all study halls held during exam periods will meet in their normal rooms. Attendance **WILL** be taken.
5. No locker passes will be issued during exam periods. Except in an emergency, only one bathroom pass will be issued at a time. Exam areas shall be quiet the entire period.
6. On Thursday, January 22nd and Friday, January 23rd, all students on the school premises during exam times are required to be in one of the three places: (1) in exam location, (2) in the Commons, or (3) in the Library.
7. Students who finish exams early must remain in their room until the end of the period.
8. Exams are mandatory in all classes including AP courses.
9. Students must take midterms during the scheduled time unless prior approval from the Principal has been received to take the exam(s) on an alternate date or time.
10. Failure to take a final exam in a semester course ending in January will result in failure of the course.
11. **Vocational classes WILL meet as usual during midterm exam week: Tuesday and Wednesday attendance is mandatory; Thursday and Friday are optional, but each student must provide his/her own transportation.**
12. Breakfast will be served on Thursday, January 22nd and Friday, January 23rd until 9:45. No lunch will be served on Thursday and Friday.
13. Late buses will run as normal during exam week, however students must have a pass in order to utilize this service.
