**Photovoice**

Photovoice gives students like you an opportunity to record and reflect current health issues through a specific photographic technique.

Once you have identified a current health issue, you will use a visual image and an accompanying story to provide a "voice" to the health issue.

The steps:

- 1) Find a current health article in a newspaper (regular or online).
- 2) Read it.
- 3) Develop ideas/themes for a photograph that would embody the main health issue.
- 4) Choose one idea for your representative photo.
- 5) Take a digital photo of your chosen idea.
- 6) Load the photo onto a computer.
- 7) Below the photo, you need to "contextualize". This means tell the story about what the photo means.  
  
Write 1-3 sentences conveying the health issue and connecting the photo others are viewing.

- 8) Include your name under the story.
- 9) Print out the photo and story on one piece of paper.  
Cutting and pasting the two together is fine, just  
make sure it is neat.
- 10) Attach the current health article to the bottom  
of your photovoice.
