ALTERNATIVES TO COLLEGE AND THE MILITARY AFTER HIGH SCHOOL

Are you wondering about alternatives to college and the military right after high school? Join representatives of the American Friends Service Committee to learn about ideas you might not be familiar with and consider what choices are right for you. Discuss questions about options and benefits in the military and learn about humanitarian service work opportunities.

BANKING CAREERS

Learn about the different types of careers in banking, the benefits, the skills you need and what to do to enter the field of banking.

BATH CAREER CENTER

Looking for a job? Not sure what to do in the future? The career center provides job listings and placement. They will do personality, interest and aptitude testing to see what career is best for you. This is a free service!

BIW APPRENTICESHIP

The Bath Iron Works Apprenticeship is a competitive training opportunity for several careers which lead to an Associates Degree from Maine Maritime Academy. Students who complete the A.A. may continue for a 4-year degree. High school graduates may apply. Students selected for Apprenticeships are earning while they are working and taking courses on-site in Bath.

CIANBRO

Cianbro is a civil and heavy industrial construction company with excellent job opportunities in Maine and the northeast. Cianbro staff will give a brief overview of the company, talk about various career options available at Cianbro and explain the type of candidates they are looking for, i.e. education, training and experience. They will also discuss some of the benefits offered at Cianbro. A short video will be included in the presentation.

CITY YEAR

City Year, a program of AmeriCorps, unites young people of all backgrounds for a year of full-time service, giving them the skills and opportunities to change the world. As tutors, mentors, and role models, these idealistic leaders make a difference in the lives of children, and transform schools and neighborhoods in 18 U.S. locations and Johannesburg, South Africa. Just as important, during their year of service corps members develop civic leadership skills they can use throughout a lifetime of community service.

COLLEGE CLOSE TO HOME

This workshop will include presentations about education opportunities at Southern New Hampshire University at Cooks Corner and University College Bath/Brunswick and Southern Maine Community Center which share the Midcoast Center for Higher Education in Bath. two- and four-year colleges. The schools on this panel offer great opportunities for students wanting to stay at or close to home or wanting to attend part-time while working.

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP SEARCHES (FAME)

A representative from FAME (Finance Authority of Maine) will show students how to conduct their own scholarship search. This will be a hands-on workshop in the Computer Center. Seniors heading to college and those concerned about funding college are especially encouraged to sign up.

DOWNEAST SCHOOL OF MASSAGE

Waldoboro, Maine

The only accredited program of its kind in the state. The school offers ten-month programs in three different types of massage.

ENGINEERING CAREERS PANEL

This workshop includes a panel of engineers: two- mechanical engineers, one of whom has specialized in energy alternatives and a welding engineer. They'll discuss their respective careers and careers in engineering.

FERRIER SCHOLARSHIP

This is for Bowdoinham students only. The Ferrier scholarship supports Bowdoinham students to do something out of the ordinary, such as lessons, special courses, various adventures ... usually not school-related, but exceptions may be considered. Learn about this opportunity so you can develop your proposal before the April 1 deadline.

FIREFIGHTING

Volunteer firefighters, including student members from the Topsham Fire Department, will discuss firefighting and demonstrate equipment. Topsham is recruiting student volunteers. Students who might consider volunteer training with the Topsham Fire Department are encouraged to attend

HEALTH PROFESSIONS CAREERS PANEL

This workshop includes a panel of health providers who will share information about their careers and training. Included are (1) a Mt. Ararat graduate who earned her R.N. at USM, worked at Midcoast and has had a range of experiences including Medivac, Rescue Transport, ER, ICU, Indian Health Service in Alaska and is earning a Masters in Forensic Nursing online; (2) an Occupational Therapist who works at Midcoast and teaches in the UMA graduate program in OT; (3) a Nurse Practitioner Women's Health Specialist who works in Lewiston and travels to Vinalhaven; (4) two Paramedic/Firefighters- one of whom has done a Middle East tour; (5) a former Nurse's Aid who is now MidCoast Hospital's Laboratory Manager.

JOB CORPS

JOB CORPS offers advanced training for up to two years in many of the vocations at residential locations in Maine and New England. After completion of one program, students are eligible to continue to college through the ACT (Advanced Career Training) program. Eligible students who have not completed high school may earn their GED or diploma through Job Corps. Training, room and board are fully-funded for those selected.

MAINE OIL DEALERS ASSOCIATION (MODA)

A MODA staff member will discuss careers in the oil industry, available jobs in Maine and the beginning and advanced courses in Oilheat Technology available at the MODA Technical Education Center in Brunswick. MODA hires and trains high school graduates.

MAINE SCHOOL OF MASONRY
Avon, Maine

The one-year Mason Apprentice Certificate program is designed for the student to develop skills and knowledge in the brick, block and stone masonry fields; trades that provide employment today as it did in the days of the pyramids. The student will develop skills through lab projects, classroom instruction and community involvement projects.

VERSO PAPER

Verso Paper has careers in high-tech manufacturing, including engineering, information technology, finance/administration and industrial trades (millwrights, instrumentation/electric technicians and precision maintenance). VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION

This workshop, conducted by Samantha Fenderson of the Bureau of Vocational Rehabilitation in the Maine Department of Labor, is for students in Special Services or students who have a 504 Plan who are not yet Vocational Rehabilitation clients. VR covers the cost of many services, education and training for eligible clients to prepare for employment.
